About your savings. Your cost for these drugs will be the lower of (1) the discount price offered through this program; or (2) the pharmacy's regular retail price. This means you are assured the lowest price in that pharmacy, at the time you purchase the drug.

Participating retail pharmacies. Discounts are available only at participating retail pharmacies. The list includes some of the retail pharmacies that participate in the program. To find out if a pharmacy not listed here participates in the program, call the pharmacy directly.

Fill your prescriptions in three easy steps:

- 1. Select a pharmacy.** Choose a participating pharmacy. Remember, discounted prices are only available at retail pharmacies participating in this program.
- 2. Present your Service Benefit Plan identification card and prescription to the pharmacist.**
- 3. Pay for your drug.** The pharmacist will tell you the cost of your drug.

Tips for saving money.

- 1.** Ask your doctor about generic drugs. Research shows that you can save, on average, 30 to 80 percent by using generics.
